EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- 1. Call USCG VHF Channel 16
 - a. MAYDAY! MAYDAY!
 - b. Location
 - c. Nature of Distress
 - d. Vessel Name and description
 - e. Number of people on board

Non-Emergency situation:

- 2. Call BML VHF Channel 16/69
 - a. Give location
 - b. Nature of problem
 - c. Type of assistance needed
 - d. Establish 1 hour or 30 minute communication schedule
- 3. Call USCG VHF Channel 16
 - a. Same as above
 - b. Request BML notification

Ensure ALL persons are wearing a Personal Flotation Device (PFD)
